DMO Comment on the evidence as a whole

The application route was awarded as a public foot road by the 1807 inclosure award. No evidence has been supplied that shows it has ever been formally stopped up. As such it still exists as a pedestrian highway and should be recorded on the definitive map. The proposed order route is longer than the application route because it reflects what was awarded by the inclosure commissioners.


