



Cases

- Number of tests that are positive
- A diagnosis rate per 100,000 population (Bench marked regionally and nationally)
- 7 day rolling average new cases
- Data from national track and trace





Symptoms

- NHS III calls triaged as COVID19
- Patients seen in general practice with symptoms
- COVID19 Symptom app: covid.joinzoe.com

Settings

- Care homes with confirmed or suspected Covid 19 cases
- Care homes with outbreaks
- Schools with outbreaks
- Outbreaks in business or workplace

Working together to improve and make a difference



Severity

- Number of patients in York Hospital with COVID19 in acute beds and in Intensive Treatment Unit receiving ventilation
- Number of patients admitted with suspected
 COVID19 in previous 24 hours
- · Residents recovered and discharged from hospital





Deaths

- ONS data total number of deaths in all settings where COVID confirmed or suspected mentioned on death certificate - (cumulative)
- Deaths per 100,000 population benchmarked nationally
- Excess deaths
- Registrar data
