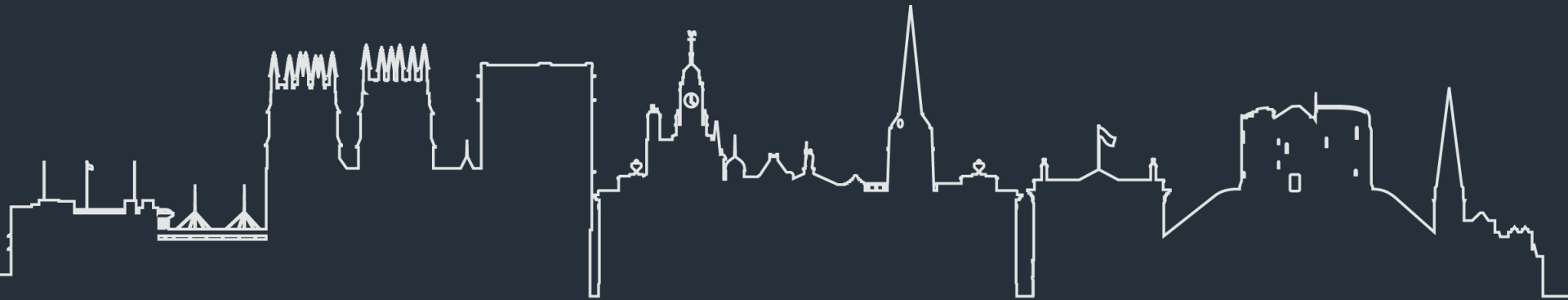

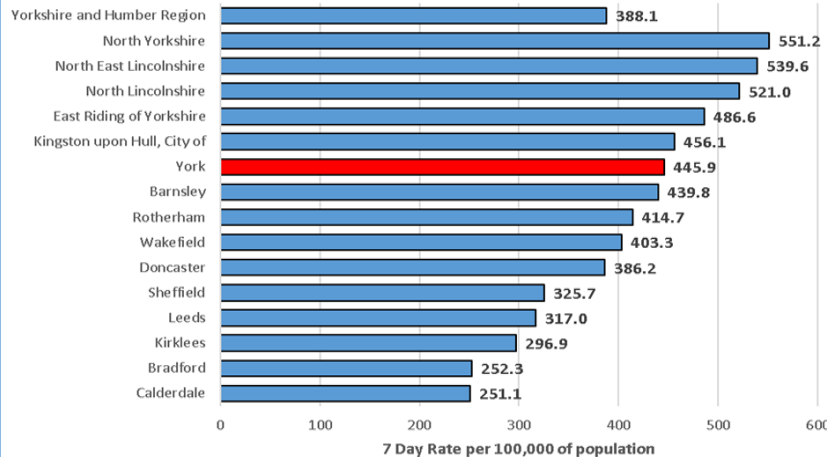

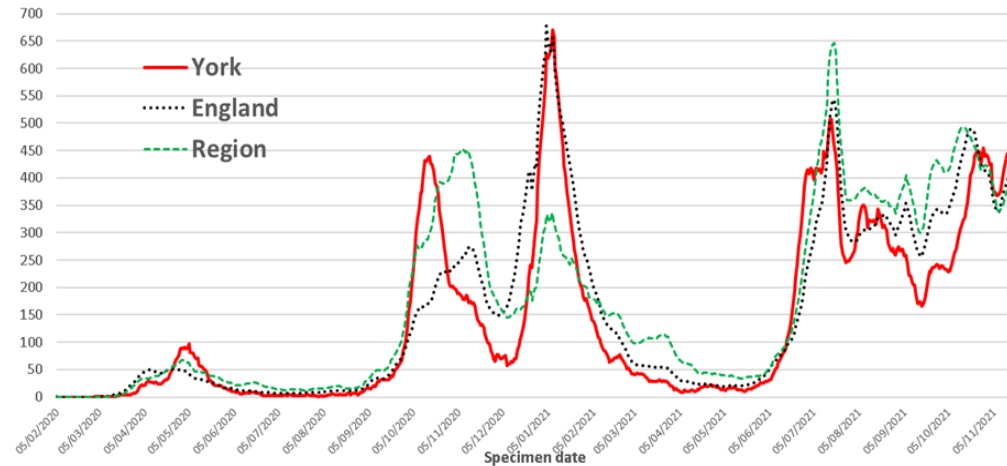

Covid 7 day rate per 100,000: Yorkshire & Humber Region

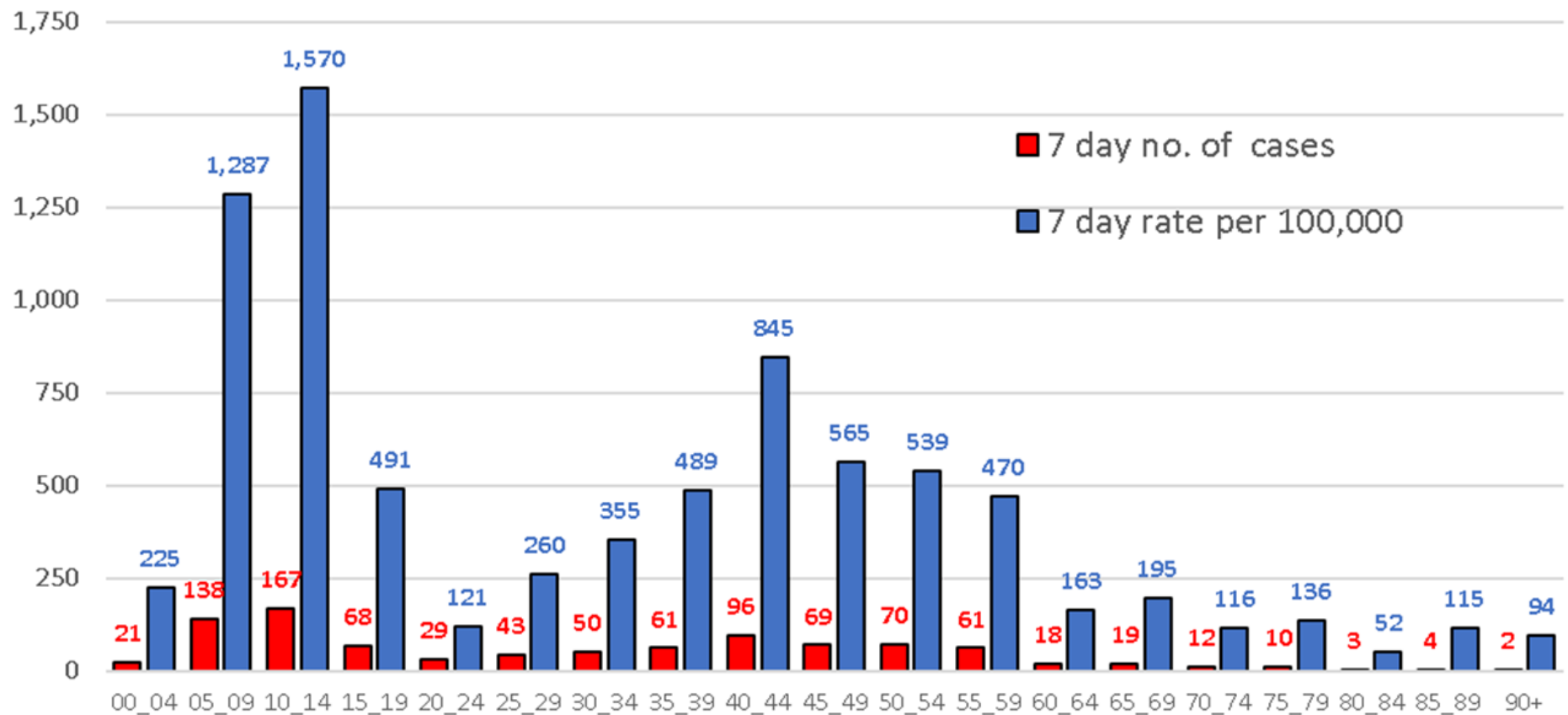


New cases in last 7 days per 100,000 of population - York

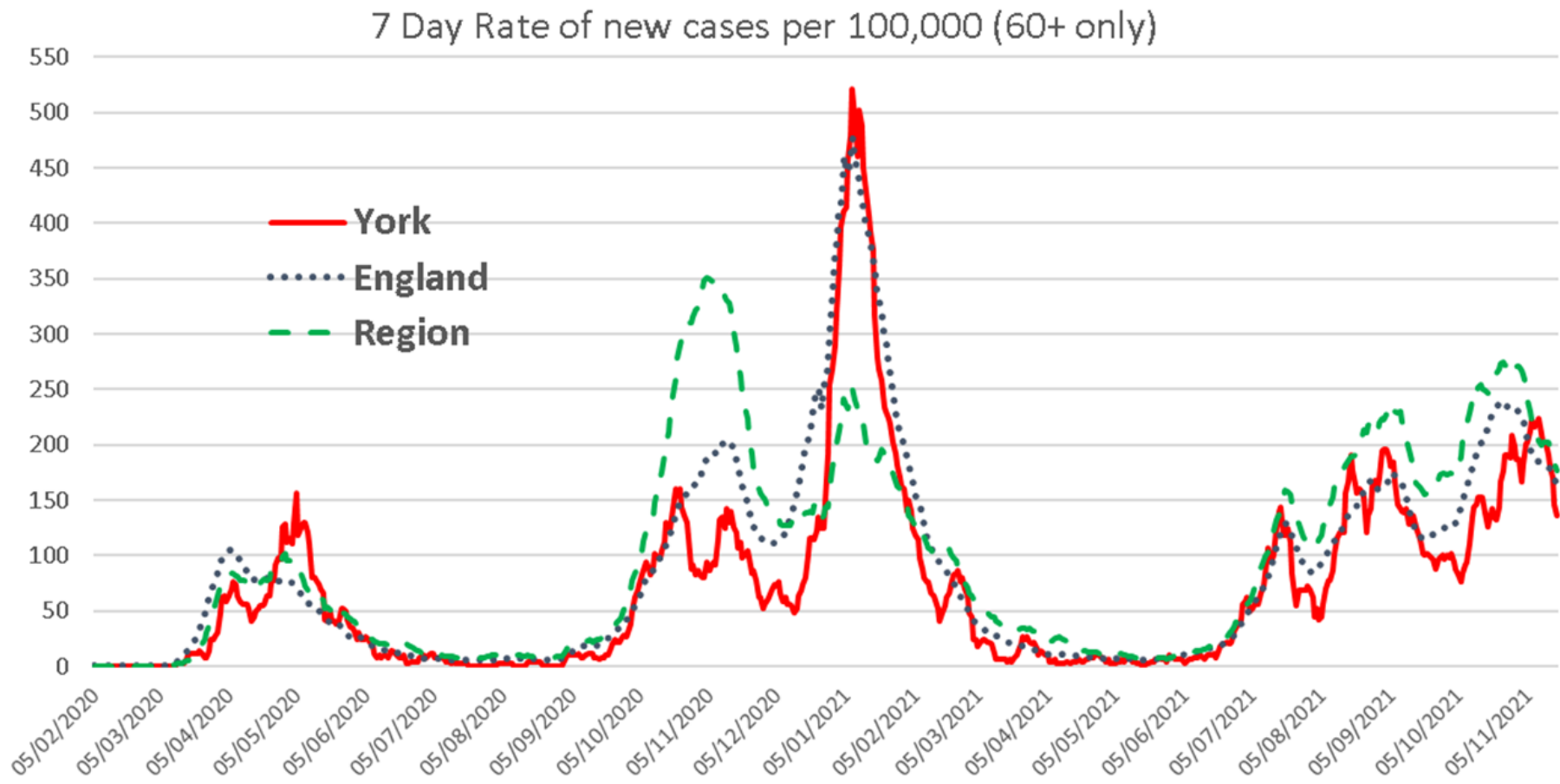


The latest official “validated” rate of new Covid cases per 100,000 of population for the period 12.11.21 to 18.11.21 in York was **445.9** (941 cases). The national and regional averages at this date were **421** and **388.1** respectively (using data published on Gov.uk on 23.11.21)

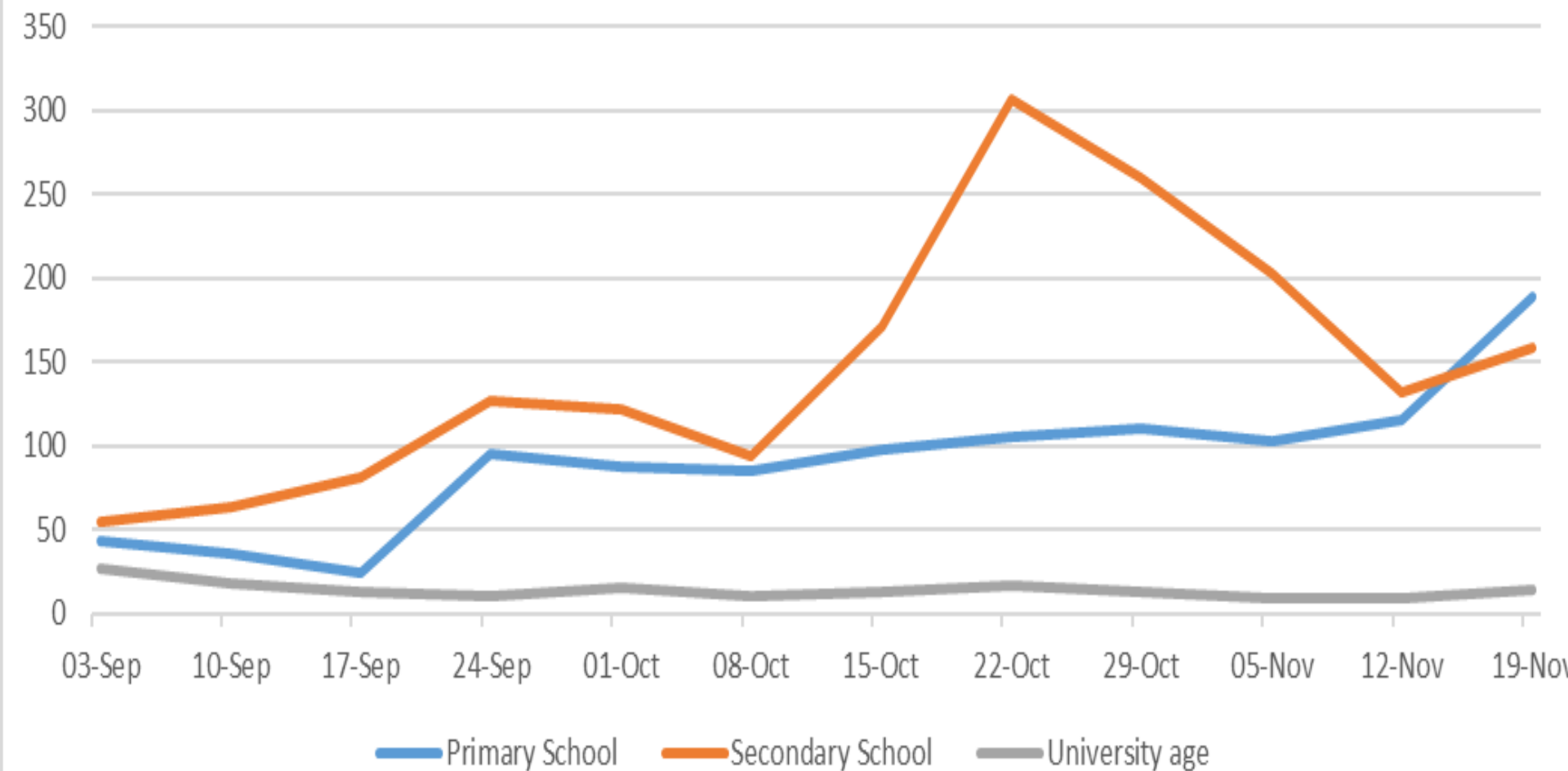
Cases in the last 7 days per 100,000 by 5 year age band in York



The rate of new Covid cases per 100,000 of population for the period 12.11.21 to 18.11.21 for people aged **60+** in York was **136.2** (68 cases). The national and regional averages were 164.3 and 176.5 respectively.



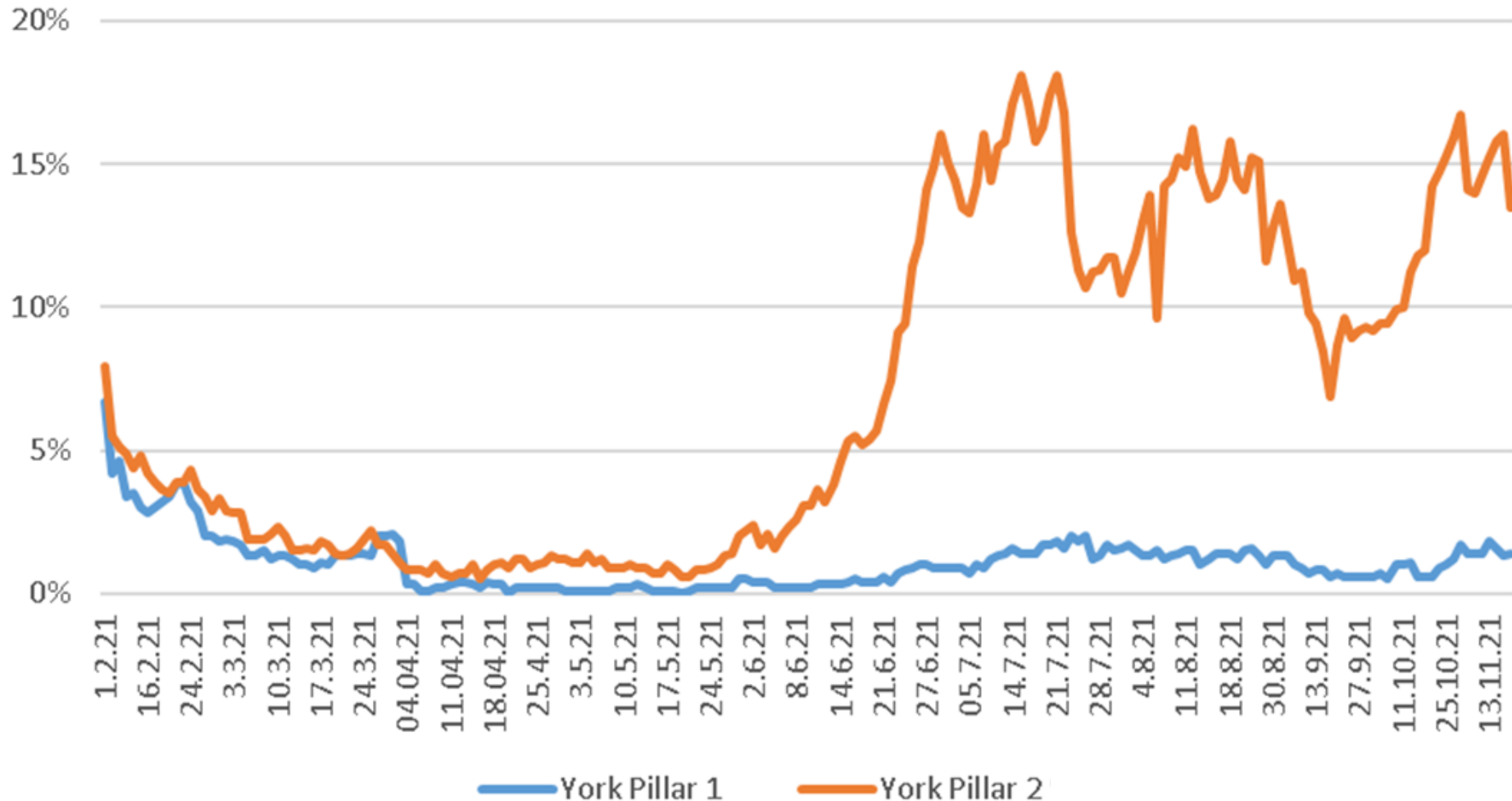

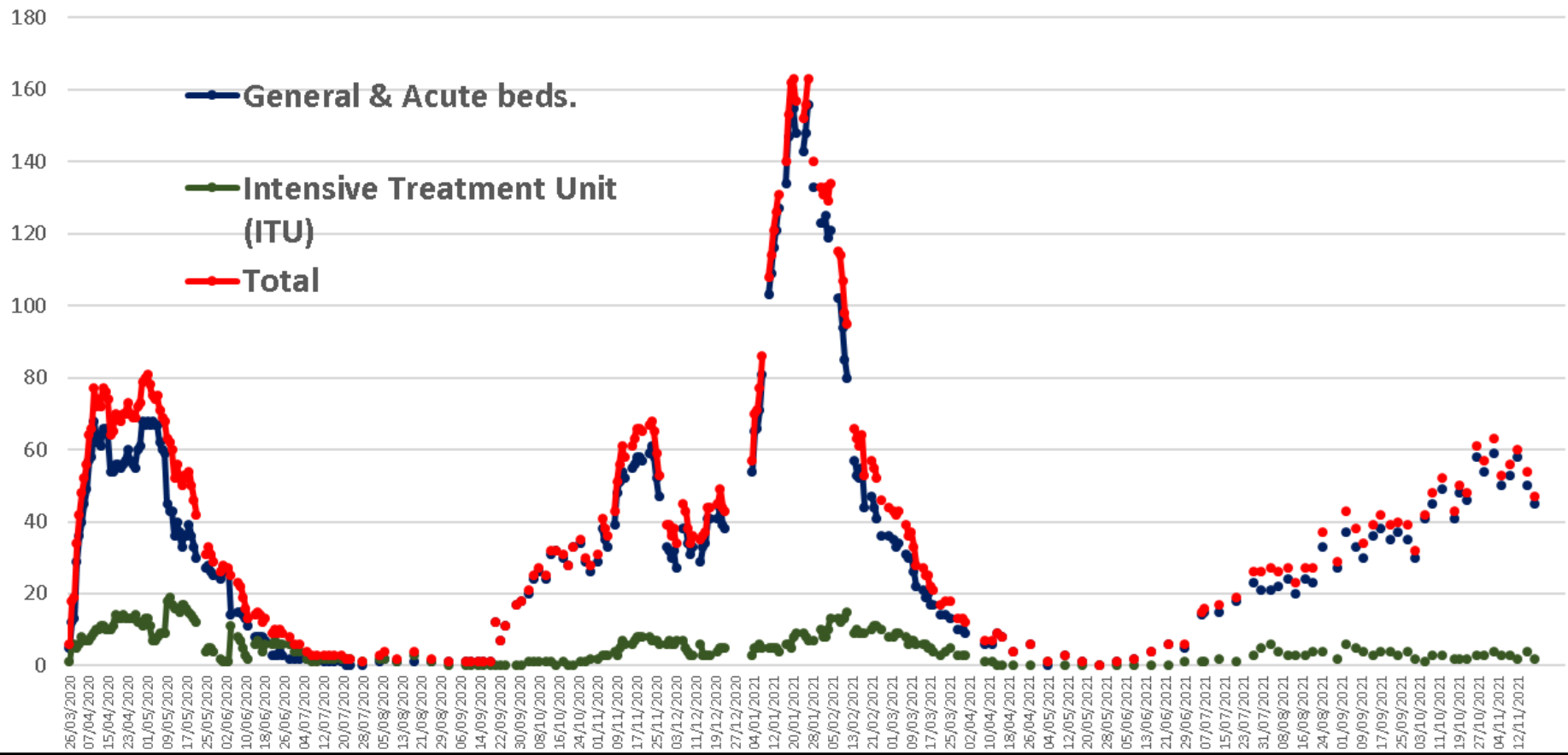
As at 20.11.21, the latest **7 day** positivity rate in York (Pillar 1 tests only) was **1.4%**. The national and regional averages are 1.6% and 2.0% respectively. As at 20.11.21 the latest **7 day** positivity rate in York (Pillar 2 tests only) was **13.5%**. The national and regional averages are 14.8% and 14.7% respectively.

7 Day Positivity Rates for York: Pillar 1 & 2 Tests (since Feb 21)

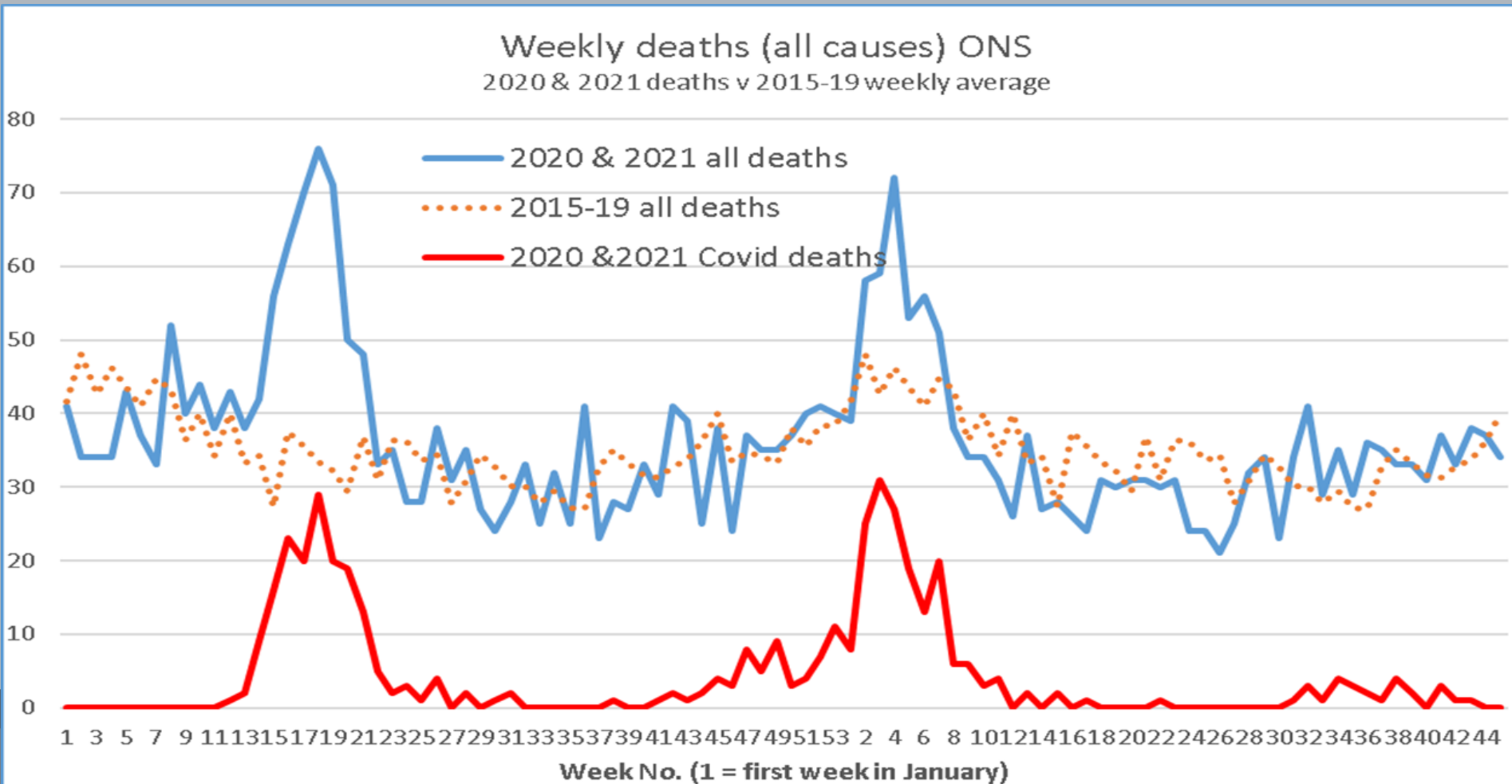


As at 19.11.21 there were **45** people with Covid in a General / Acute bed and **2** in ITU.

Confirmed Covid 19 patients in Beds at York Hospital

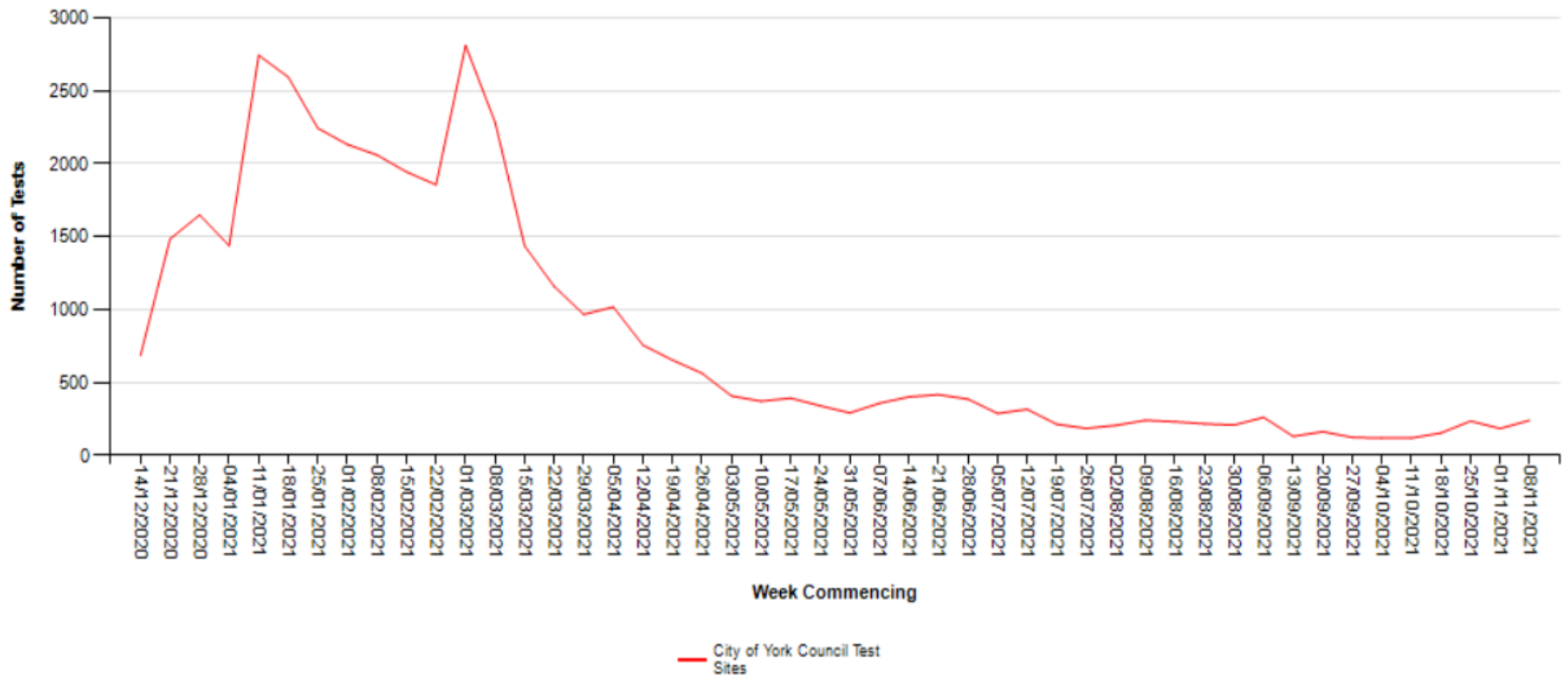


Since the start of the pandemic, for deaths occurring up to 12th November 2021 and registered up to 20th November 2021, **427** Covid-19 deaths were recorded as having occurred for CYC residents (250 in hospital, 140 in care homes, 29 at home/elsewhere and 8 in a hospice). There have been **156** 'excess deaths' in York since the start of the 2020 (using the 2015-2019 weekly average number of deaths as the comparator)

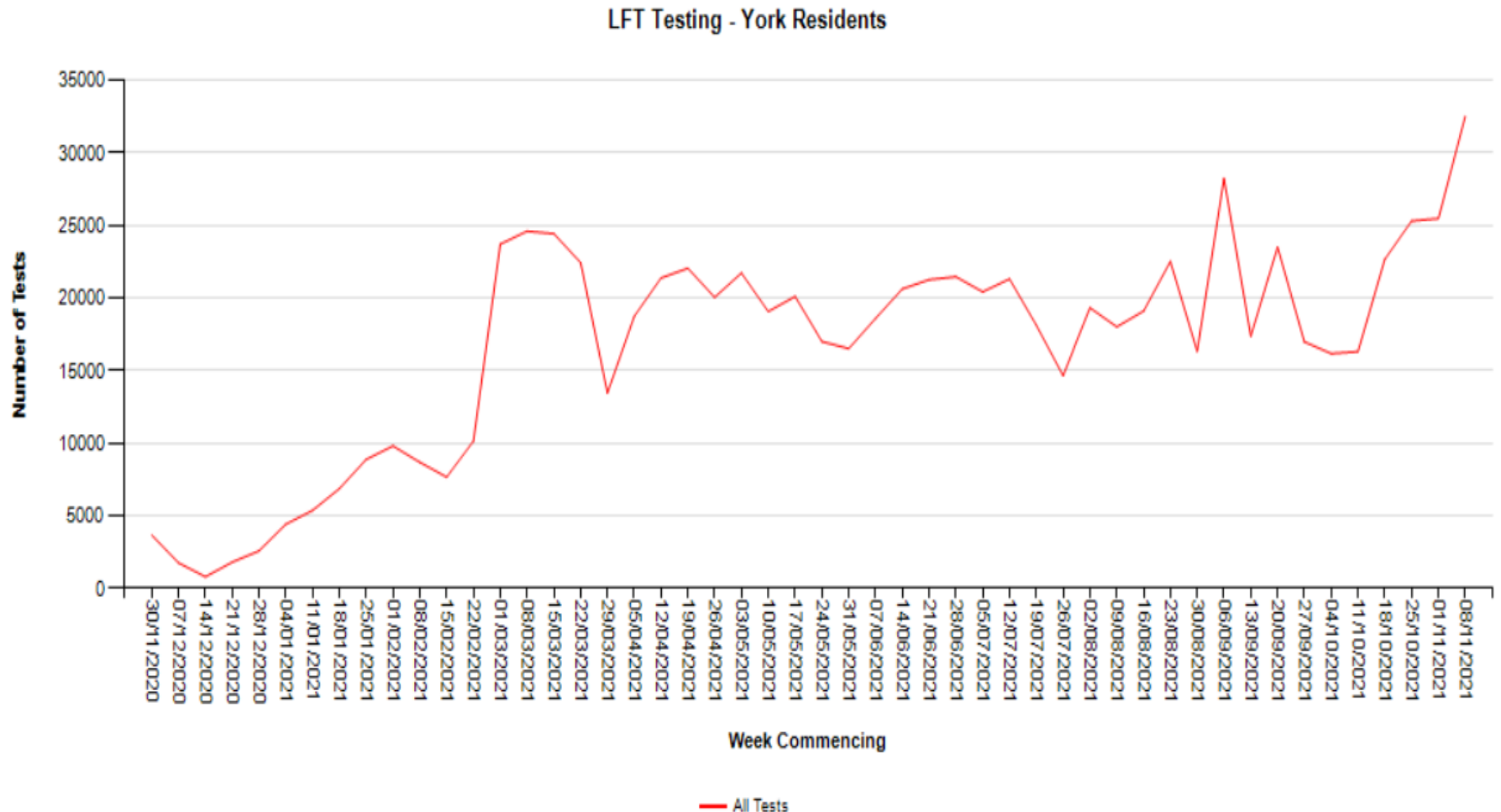


Tests administered at Council run test sites

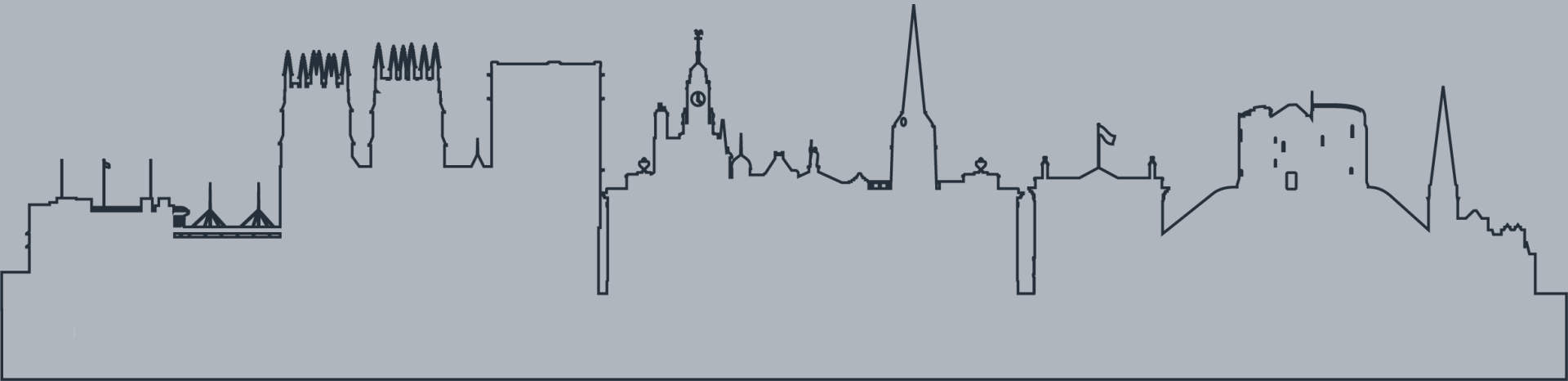
