Background						
In previous years, the installation of the UK CT barrier assets in the city centre has been highlighted as a necessary but very unattractive solution to making the city safe. For Xmas 2022, Make It York have proposed using £10k of the York UK Shared Prosperity Fund allocation to wrap each of the 20 barriers (ie £500 per barrier). This is in scope for UKSPF funds, with CT Barriers specifically identified in the York Investment Plan. We are free to commission Make It York to undertake the work through our Teckal arrangements. Implications for the barriers are not a consequence of this decision, which only applies to improving their appearance, not the decision to install them per se.
