Over the past few years, schools have been extending the services they offer. Many now open up their facilities outside school hours for pupils, their families and the local community. These school activities are activities that happen **in addition** to the normal school day.

What's on offer depends on what local people want. If it cannot be offered on site, it can usually be found nearby. Examples of what schools are offering are:

## For Children and young people

- Homework clubs and study support
- Holiday clubs
- Activities for children and young people

## For adults

- Family Learning
- Information sessions
- Parenting and family support
- Swift & easy referral to specialist service:
- Facilities for community use (e.g. sports groups, computer groups etc)

The Committee will explore in detail the affordability, quality and take-up of childcare and activities for children aged 5-11, and identify ways of ensuring their affordability.
