Pollinator Strategy - CYC will organise a Development Plan when the Local Plan has been adopted.

Enhancing Bio-diversity - the council is keen to push the planting of wild flowers at the school and the Church.

Cllr Young reported that the Scout Group is in need of funding. It was proposed that a grant of £500 be payable now and a further £500, on request, if there isn't any snow.
