1) Introductions and Apologies

2) Minutes and actions from previous meeting

 It was agreed that the circulated minutes were an accurate record of the 19th April meeting.

- SFr will commission an updated bus route map following the latest round of service changes.
- SFr and AC met to discuss issues with timetable data.
- JR/SFr held a meeting with tour bus operators and agreed a resolution to the Exhibition Square issue.
- Action carried forward: DMc to arrange BetterPoints meeting with bus operators.

3) Summer All York Ticket offer

- Ticketing Group have agreed the principle of a half-price (£5.50) discount offer for the All York Family Day ticket this summer.
- The ticket is valid for up to 2 adults and 3 children.
- Fare discounted will be reimbursed from BSIP revenue.
- It was agreed that the offer should be valid during the York school summer holidays, ie Sat 22nd Jul until Sun 3rd Sep 2023.
- Marketing Group tasked with promoting the offer.

4) Marketing proposals

- LT explained that the marketing group is seeking to procure a contractor to assist with strategic marketing of BSIP-funded measures until March 2025.

- Some of the previously-approved £200k behaviour change funding will be used for this purpose.
