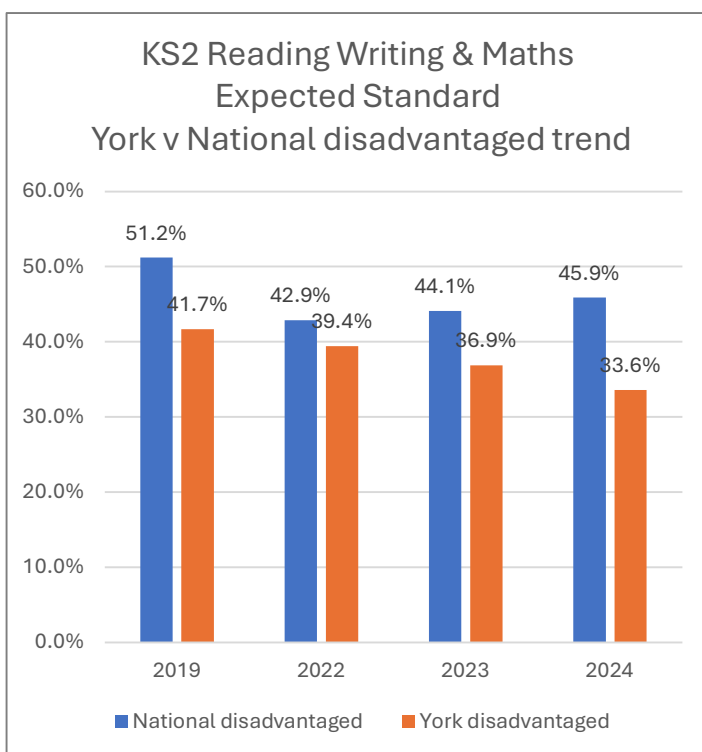


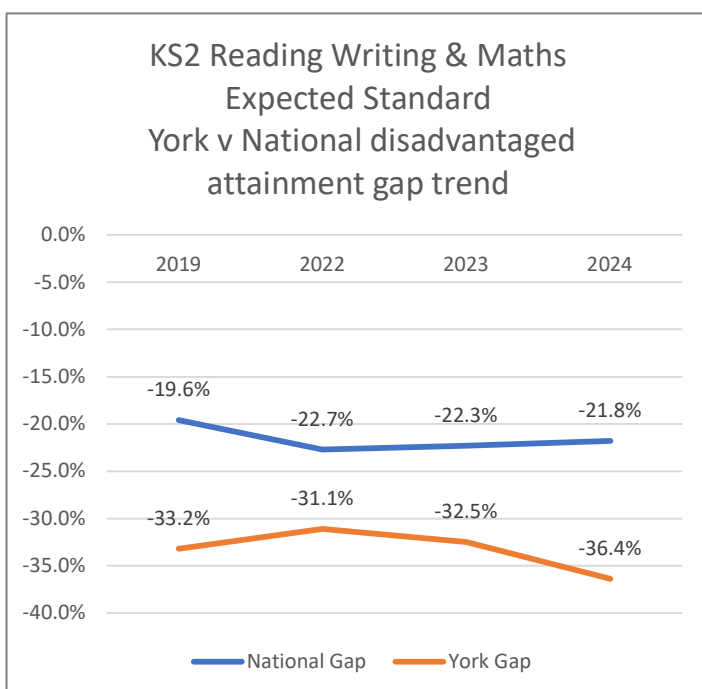
Key Stage 2 Reading Writing and Mathematics

Key Stage 2 RWM expected standard Year 2023/2024 disadvantaged cohort outcome



KS2 Reading Writing and Maths (RWM) combined Expected Standard: In York, 33.6% (139 out of 414) of the disadvantaged cohort achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths, 12.3% lower than the national average of 45.5%. York LA's disadvantaged cohort's Expected Standard in Reading, Writing and Maths combined has decreased by 3.3% from 36.9% in 2022-23. The disadvantaged pupils in York are in percentile 94 for Reading, Writing & Maths Expected Standard compared to percentile 43 for their non-disadvantaged peers compared to other LAs.

Key Stage 2 RWM expected standard Year -2023/2024 disadvantaged attainment gap



The attainment gap in KS2 RWM between York LA's disadvantaged and their non-disadvantaged peers has increased by 3.9% since 2022-23. York LA's disadvantaged attainment gap of -36.4% is 14.6% points, significantly more than the national disadvantaged attainment gap of -21.8%. In York, since the 2018-19 outcomes (pre-Covid Pandemic) to 2022-24, the KS2 RWM attainment gap between the disadvantaged cohort and their non-disadvantaged peers has increased by 3.2% from -33.2% in 2018-19 to -36.4% in 2023-24.
