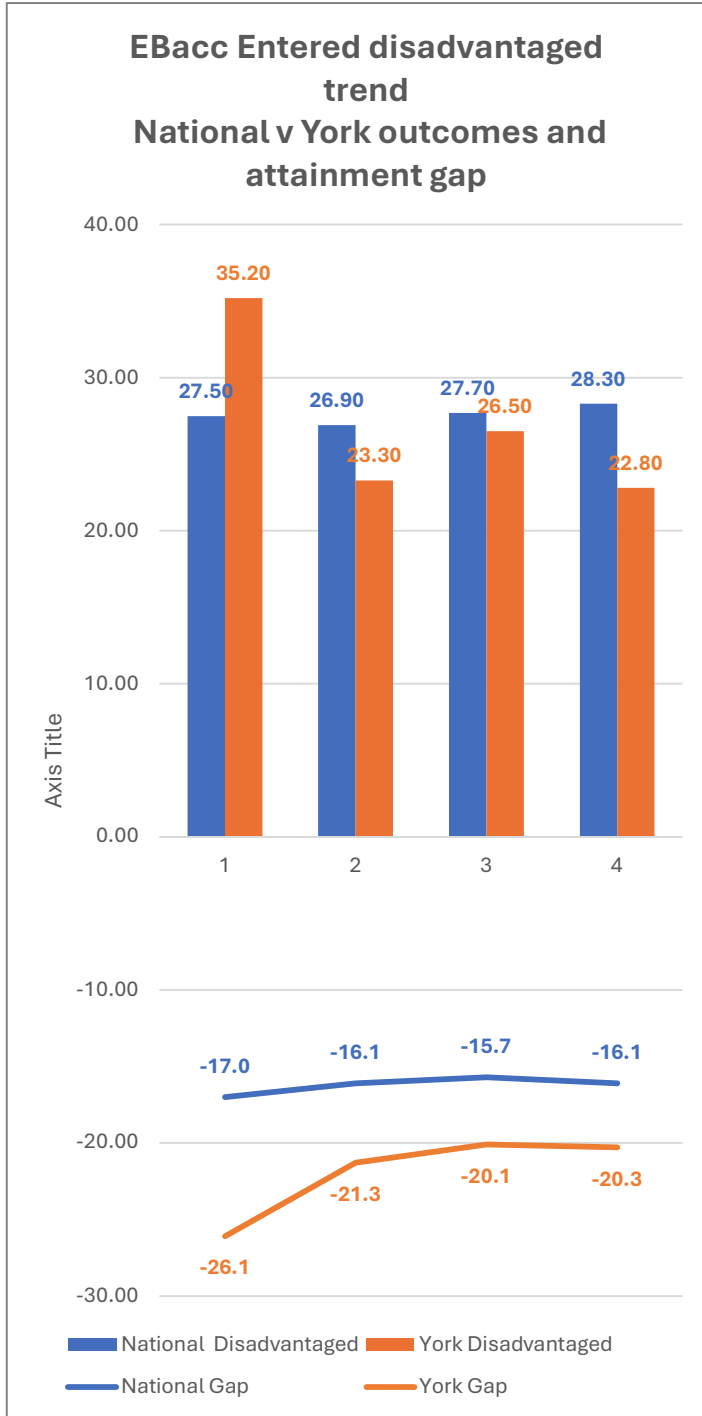


Key Stage 4 EBacc Entered

EBacc Entered disadvantaged trend National v York outcomes and attainment gap to non-disadvantaged peers



KS4 EBacc Entered: 22.8% of York LA's disadvantaged cohort were entered for English Baccalaureate, 74 pupils out of 325; this is 5.5% points lower than the national disadvantaged cohort at 28.3%. York LA's disadvantaged cohort's KS4 EBacc Entered percentage has decreased by 3.7% points, from 26.5% in 2022-23 to 22.8% in 2023-24. The disadvantaged pupils in York LA are in percentile 64 for EBacc Entered compared to other LAs.

The attainment gap in EBacc Entered between York LA's disadvantaged and their non-disadvantaged peers has increased by 0.2% since 2022-23. At -20.3%, York LA's disadvantaged EBacc Entered attainment gap is 4.2% points wider than the national disadvantaged attainment gap of -16.1%. In York, from the outcomes in 2018-19, prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, to the latest outcomes in 2023-24, the EBacc Entered attainment between the disadvantaged cohort and their peers has narrowed by 5.8% points from -26.1% to -20.3%.
