Update on Implementation of Recommendations of Previous Scrutiny Reviews

Summary

1. This report provides Members with update information on the implementation of recommendations made as a result of previously completed scrutiny reviews on Guidance for Sustainable Development and Planning Enforcement.

Background

2. In the past the Scrutiny Management Committee (SMC) have monitored the implementation of recommendations arising from Scrutiny Reviews. Under the new scrutiny structure responsibility for this falls with the individual scrutiny committees.
