Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

MANDATORY CONDITIONS WHERE LICENCE AUTHORISES SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL

(1) In accordance with section 19 of the Licensing Act 2003, where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the licence must include the following conditions.

(2) The first condition is that no supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

(a) at a time where there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or

(b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

(3) The second condition is that every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

MANDATORY CONDITION: DOOR SUPERVISION

(1) In accordance with section 21 of the Licensing Act 2003, where a premises licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, the licence must include a condition that each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

(2) But nothing in subsection (1) requires such a condition to be imposed (a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c.12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or

(b) in respect of premises in relation to -

(i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or

(ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).

(3) For the purposes of this section -

(a) 'security activity' means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and

(b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

For Regulated Entertainment consisting of Music and Dancing

a) The licence holder shall attach a copy of the City Council's Rules for the Management of Places of Public Entertainment to the valid licence. This document shall form part of the licence.

b) The licence holder shall ensure prompt compliance with any written report received from the City Council.

c) The licence holder shall ensure prompt compliance with any written report received from North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service.

d) The maximum occupancy of the licensed premises shall not exceed the following numbers at any time:

Ground Floor - 300 persons First Floor - 100 persons

e) There shall be no external speakers.

f) All external doors to the riverside of the premises will be closed at 21:00.

g) The main entrance doors will be kept closed at all times and only used for ingress and egress.

Licensing Objectives

General

1. The premise will respect the Managements Companies Approach to Responsible Drinking

Prevention of Crime & Disorder

2. When door staff are used they be Security Industry Authority approved and operate in accordance with security industry guidelines.

3. A zero tolerance towards illegal drugs will be enforced at all times.

4. If a DJ is used on any night they will ask customers to leave quietly.

5. All instances of crime and disorder will be reported to the police and will be kept in an incident log book.

6. If the premise opens past 02:00 hours door supervisors shall be employed.

Public Safety

7. A health and safety policy is in place.

8. The policy is fully briefed and trained to all management and staff. Continued training of staff is undertaken to the standards required by relevant legislation.

9. Free drinking water will be available at all times.

Public Nuisance

10. Additional patrols will take place by members of staff, internally and externally to limit any noise pollution when entertainment is being offered within the premise.

11. Notices are displayed at exits asking customers to respect neighbours when leaving the premise.

12. No noise nuisance is to be caused by noise emanating from the premise.

13. No sound reproduction or amplification equipment (mechanical or electrical) shall be used in, or adjacent to any part of the building at anytime for the purpose of external use.

14. All doors and windows shall be closed after 23:00 hours when regulated entertainment is taking place.

15. The use of the beer garden shall be restricted to 23:00 hours Monday - Sunday.

Protection of Children from Harm

16. When children are allowed upon the premise, any entertainment offered within the premise will be suitable for young persons.

17. Children will be required to be supervised by accompanying adult at all times.

18. A no smoking area is provided.

19. A recognised proof of age policy is in place.
