CHURCHILL HOTEL, BOSTHAM - EXTENSION OF LICENCE - LYC 009632

Dear Mrs Cockerell

1. I am not in favour of this application and object.
2. Our flat overlooks the Churchill Hotel (as do several others ^{in this block} and adjacent ^{residential} properties).
3. Since the Churchill Hotel instituted their own smoking restriction, our summer ^{weekend} nights, often till 1.00 in the morning, are disrupted by residents & visitors to the hotel who spend their time outdoors.
4. On 4 occasions last summer I complained ^{by telephone} (between 11.30 - 12.45 AM) to the Churchill Hotel about noise but they said there is nothing they can do!
5. The existing licence should be reconsidered as local residents suffer from the nuisance.
6. We have lived here for over 4 years and there has been no trouble until last summer.
7. The statutory notices on the railings outside the Churchill Hotel have been removed.
