Reference: - Notice of Application for a Premises Licence – Applefields School, Bad Bargain Lane

We would like to make an objection to the above premises licence application on the following public nuisance grounds:-

1. The school is in very close proximity to a number of residential dwellings who suffer continuous noise daily from the 11 to 19 year old pupils. We accept, reluctantly, that there will be some daytime noise, but we do not expect to hear any noise on an evening.
2. The play area is adjacent to our boundaries.
3. A certain amount of respect has been shown over the years from our point of view. We have not used any form of motorised garden equipment during school hours as we realize that this would upset the pupils and spoil their playtimes.
4. Just before the Summer holidays they had a disco at the school one evening, and we were unable to sit in our back garden as the music was so loud. We could even hear the thudding of the music inside the house. We thought this was a one off event and did not complain.
5. We feel that any other individuals or parties using the school would have no concern at all for neighbouring properties.

We would therefore ask that you please consider these points when processing this application.

Re: Notice of Application for a Premises Licence – Applefields School.

We would like to make an objection to the above based on the following:
