

Dear Sir or Madam,

We the undersigned would like to lodge an objection to the application for a premises license from the Pupil Support Centre at Danesgate, Fulford Cross, posted on 1st October 2007. There are three main parts to our objection.

Timing of activities

Firstly the license application requests that all the listed activities take place at any time between 0800 and 2300 hours on any day of the week, including Saturday and Sunday. This would contravene the planning permission for the buildings, which states; 'The use of the buildings hereby approved shall cease by 9pm and the site be entirely vacated by 10pm, Monday to Friday and shall not be used at all on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.'

We object to the buildings being used for activities after 9pm and request that the original planning permission is adhered to.

Location of activities

The license application requests that activities A (plays), F (Recorded music), G (Performance of Dance), I (Provision of facilities for making music) and J (Provision of facilities for dancing) can take place both indoors and outdoors. We object to any of these activities occurring outdoors as we are concerned about the potential noise levels in a quiet residential area.

Nature of activities

Again, because of potential noise levels we object to the application to use the buildings for E (Live music), F (Recorded music), G (Performance of Dance) and H (Anything of similar description to that falling within E, F and G). We also object to clauses I (Provision of facilities for making music) and J (Provision of facilities for dancing).

The original planning application stated that 'the new building would primarily be used to offer opportunities for post 16 year olds to develop a range of skills which will be taught in this building.' It then goes on to say, 'these include painting and decorating, joinery, hairdressing and IT. It is essentially a vocational trade skills centre for young people.' Further on in the planning application there is also mention that 'eventually the Skills Centre will also offer vocational courses to the wider community.'
